AHLA supports mandated human trafficking training in every hotel and the AHLA Foundation's 'No Room For Trafficking' initiative builds on the industry's ongoing work to end human trafficking.

## LEGISLATIVE COMMITMENT IN NEW YORK

The hotel industry has a history of working with nationally recognized experts on human trafficking awareness and prevention efforts. In 2022, New York State mandated that all hotel employees in the state, including in NYC, undergo human trafficking awareness and prevention training within 60 days of being hired.
