- Remove/rearrange furniture
- Provide remote shopping alternatives (e.g., delivery, pick-up)
- Ask customers who are ill to stay home
- Consider policies that encourage flexible sick leave and alternative work schedules.
- Schedule stocking during off-peak hours

## **Cleaning and Disinfection**

- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces, (e.g., counters, shelving, displays)
- Provide employees with disposable disinfectant wipes, cleaner, or sprays that are effective against the virus that causes COVID-19

## **Training**

Provide employees with training on:

- Policies to reduce the spread of COVID-19
- General hygiene
- Symptoms, what to do if sick
- Cleaning and disinfection
- Cloth face covers
- Social distancing
- Use of PPE
- Safe work practices
- Stress management
