



Human Trafficking Core Legislative Principles

These provisions are intended to provide key elements for legislation, some of which may not be appropriate or applicable in certain jurisdictions or circumstances. Additionally, all provisions should be considered and potentially modified in light of local concerns and dynamics. Some provisions herein may be redundant or in conflict with each other.

- Training program—
 - A hotel or lodging company may use a training program developed or acquired in consultation with a regionally, nationally or globally, recognized organization with expertise in anti-trafficking initiatives, or by local or state governments.
