Summary impacts

Key findings

Hotel industry economic impacts in the City of Denver in 2025:

- 169 hotels
- 26,460 guest rooms
- 6.9 million room nights sold
- Total impact of \$6.9 billion
- \$2.5 billion wages and salaries supported
- 33,809 jobs supported
- \$4.1 billion contributed to GDP
- \$1.1 billion in total taxes generated

Additional facts for 2025:

- Hotel sales of \$1.8 billion (revenue, plus certain taxes)
- Hotels directly supported 8,879 jobs and \$605.2 million wages and salaries.
- Hotel operations supported \$454.7 million of federal, state and local taxes.
- Hotel guests spent \$4.3 billion at hotels and local businesses, and on transportation, equivalent to \$625 per room night.

Fiscal impacts

Key findings

City of Denver hotels supported \$1.1 billion of total taxes in 2025.

- Tax impacts of hotels include \$154.9 million of local taxes on lodging, including Lodger's tax and Tourism Improvement District tax. Additionally, we estimate \$180.8 million total local property taxes and \$97.0 million total local sales taxes.
- The total impacts of hotels supported \$157.1 million of state taxes, including \$98.3 million of sales tax (includes state sales tax on lodging).
- Hotels supported a total of \$476.2 million of federal taxes.
