Starting October 1, 2020 all U.S. citizens ages 18 and up will need a REAL ID-compliant driver's license or another accepted form of identification to **BOARD FLIGHTS WITHIN THE U.S**.

Here's how to make sure you're #REALIDready.



CHECK FOR THE STAR

REAL ID-compliant licenses are generally marked with a star located in the upper corner of the card. If you're not sure about your current ID, contact your state's department of motor vehicles or driver's license agency.















GET A REAL ID

Contact your department of motor vehicles or driver's license agency to learn your state's **REAL ID process.** Make sure you have all necessary documentation before arriving onsite to begin the process to secure a REAL ID.



UNABLE TO GET A REAL ID?

If you're unable to get a REAL ID before October 1, 2020: TSA will accept other forms of ID so you can still board your flight, including:

- ★ U.S. passport
- ★ U.S. military ID
- ★ Enhanced Driver's License (MI, MN, NY, VT and WA)
- ★ DHS trusted traveler cards (Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST)
