- Do not excuse inappropriate behavior including offensive jokes that may leave someone feeling uncomfortable.
- Keep an eye on someone in a vulnerable situation.
- Support staff and co-workers who confide in you.
- Get someone home safely if she or he has had too much to drink.
- Don't look the other way, step in if you see someone needs help.
- Never blame the victim.
- Take reports of sexual assault seriously.
